Our school is taking part in the 2021 Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS). This survey will ask about the health behaviors of 7th and 8th grade students in Strafford County. The **YRBS** will ask about injuries, bullying, violence, tobacco, alcohol, and other drug use.

Students will be asked to fill out a questionnaire that takes about 45 minutes to complete.

Doing these paper and pencil surveys will cause little or no risk to your child. The only potential risk is that some students might find certain questions to be sensitive. The surveys have been designed to protect your child's privacy. Students will not put their names on the surveys. Also, no class or student will ever be mentioned by name in the results. The results of this survey will help students in the future. We would like all students to take part in the survey, **but the surveys are voluntary**. No action will be taken against the school, you, or your child if your child does not participate. Students can skip any question that they do not wish to answer. In addition, students may stop participating in the survey at any point without penalty.
